**ADOPT A SHELF** Keeping library shelves tidy and in proper order requires constant attention and we could use more help with that. We have a growing corps of patrons who have adopted a shelf or shelves as **Book Facers** or **Shelf Readers**. We would like to expand their number so that all shelves of materials have been adopted.

The Book Facer's job is very straightforward and quick: stand books up straight, line them up to the edge of the shelf, and push the book end in place. The Book Facer always works with the set of shelves which s/he has adopted.

The Shelf Reader checks to make sure that books on her adopted shelves are in correct alphabetical or Dewey Decimal order.
